StudentVoice is an exciting new organisation working to be the representative body for secondary school students. We are committed to the idea that students' views should be considered in all decision-making: in their school, in their community, and on a national level.

StudentVoice Schools is for schools who support these goals and want to improve their student voice practice. The project is co-delivered by Phoenix Education Trust, a charity which has been providing training and consultation services to schools for fourteen years.

FOURTEEN YEARS OF EXPERIENCE

StudentVoice Schools have access to Phoenix Education Trust's services for free or at a discounted price. Phoenix was founded by Lord Young of Dartington in 2001. Since then it has worked in partnership with students, teachers and funding organisations to amplify student voice and embed a collaborative culture within schools.

Phoenix works with all members of the school community so that when it comes to making decisions about education everyone can have a voice.

Phoenix offers:

- Skills training for students
- CPD training for teachers and/or governors
- A consultation tool, Questions for Change, to inform school improvement
- A year-long support programme, encompassing all of the above, to bolster student voice, develop skills, and support school improvement through culture change.

QUESTIONS FOR CHANGE

Questions for Change is offered to free for all StudentVoice Schools. It is a unique, cutting-edge online consultation and audit tool that provides a rounded analysis of the current state of the school's student voice practice.

It engages directly with the whole school community and compliments our tailored consultations and training. There are versions for parents, teachers, governors and students. It covers areas such as:

- effectiveness of the school council,
- use of consultations,
- student-teacher feedback,
- student-governor collaboration
- school decision making.

This is a transformative process which supports schools to develop a culture of respect and collaboration which results in increased engagement from all members of the school community. An important principle of Questions for Change is that the information comes from the school community as part of its journey of self-reflection. Following the audit, Phoenix produces a report with analysis and recommendations.
